Adult Day Centers

Adult day care centers are designed to provide care and companionship for seniors who need assistance or supervision during the day. The goals of the programs are to delay or prevent institutionalization by providing alternative care, to enhance self-esteem and to encourage socialization.

There are two types of adult day care:

- 1. Adult social day care: provides social activities, meals, recreation and some health related services
- 2. Adult day health care: offers more intensive health, therapeutic and social services for individuals with severe medical problems and those at risk of requiring nursing home care.

Seniors generally take part in the program on a scheduled basis and the services that are offered may include the following:

- Counseling
- Education
- Evening care
- Exercise
- Health screening
- Meals
- Medical care

- Physical therapy
- Recreation
- Respite care
- Socialization
- Supervision
- Transportation
- Medication Management

These centers are usually open during working hours and may stand alone or be located in senior centers, nursing facilities, churches or synagogues, hospitals, or schools. The staff may monitor medications, serve hot meals and snacks, perform physical or occupational therapy, and arrange social activities. They also may help to arrange transportation to and from the center itself.

Questions to Ask Adult Day Centers

- 1. How many years has the center been in operation?
- 2. What are the days/hours of operation? What is the policy on late arrival or late pick-up?
- 3. What is the staff to participant ratio?
- 4. What training does staff receive?
- 5. Does the center have a physician, nurse or health care professional on staff or on call?
- 6. What ancillary services are offered? Transportation, bathing, hair styling, podiatry, etc.
- 7. Do participants have access to services such as physical or occupational therapy?
- 8. Will the center dispense medication and/or offer medication reminders?
- 9. Are meals and or snacks provided? Can you accommodate special diets?
- 10. How will the center evaluate the person's needs, interests and abilities?
- 11. Does the center provide services for people with different types of impairments as well as those in good physical health? i.e. Dementia, TBI, Intellectual Disabilities?
- 12. At what point is a person no longer eligible to receive care at the center?
- 13. What types of payments are accepted? (Long term care programs/Medicaid; long term care insurance, veterans benefits)
